Night-time Prowler

Chico, CA –

During the early morning hours of Thursday, October 31st, 2019 patrol officers responded to the report of a burglary alarm at Pick and Pull (397 E. Park Ave., Chico).

The alarm company had contacted 911 to report a subject within the fenced area of the property going through vehicles.

Responding officers located the subject, later identified as 32-year-old local transient David Bowers, inside the fenced area of the business. Bowers was uncooperative and fled on foot to an adjacent property.

Units monitoring the perimeter of the business were able to keep Bowers contained while K9 Aron and his handler were brought in to search for Bowers. K9 Aron located Bowers hiding under debris in an adjacent property. Bowers was arrested without further incident.

This is the third time the Chico Police Department has arrested Bowers for stealing from Pick and Pull in 2019.

Bowers was transported to the Butte County Jail for a charge of 647(h) PC - Prowling.
