### ***Residential Burglary***

**Chico, CA** – On Saturday, November 2, 2019 at about 11:37 AM, the Chico Police Department received a report of a residential burglary that was occurring at 1902 Normal Avenue. The resident reported he witnessed the suspect, later identified as Howard Todd, a Chico transient, exit the front door of a residence that he was in the process of remodeling, wearing clothing belonging to him. The resident followed Todd to the 200 block of W. 22<sup>nd</sup> Street where he was contacted by Officers from the Chico Police Department.

After Officers spoke to the resident, it was determined Todd was also in possession of multiple items of jewelry belonging to the resident when he was confronted. Further investigation later revealed Todd attempted multiple points of entry into the residence, but eventually made entry into the home through a dog door. Inside the residence Officers located multiple items of evidence indicating Todd was inside the home to include bandages that Todd was wearing due to preexisting burns he had suffered approximately five weeks previously.

Todd was arrested for residential burglary and transported to a local hospital to be evaluated. After receiving medical treatment, Todd was transported to Butte County Jail.
