Attempt Vehicle Theft

On February 11, 2019 at 7:44am, a Les Schwab employee noticed an RV, which was previously parked by the business, appeared to have been tampered with. The employee made contact at the RV and found two suspects inside attempting to “hotwire” the ignition. The suspects attempted to persuade the employee they were given permission to be inside and attempt to move it. Chico Police was called to the scene where an investigation ensued. It was determined the two suspects were providing false information as the registered owner was contacted and had not given permission for anyone to move the vehicle. Suspect(s) **ANTHONY RIPPERGER (DOB: 8-31-81) & RENALDO PEREZ (7-1-84)** were placed under arrest for attempted vehicle theft and transported to the Butte County Jail.
