Chico – On Sunday, September 11, 2022, all City of Chico fire stations will hold a brief September 11<sup>th</sup> remembrance beginning at 7:00 AM. At that time, all on duty Chico Fire Rescue Department members will assemble at attention in front of their fire station or apparatus. Once assembled, all members will maintain silence. Each fire station flag will be fully raised and then lowered to half-staff position. At 7:05 AM, Dispatch will read a brief statement over the radio followed by a minute of silence.

At the conclusion of the moment of silence, one member at Stations 1 and 2 will ring the station bell in the customary fire service manner for line-of-duty deaths in memory of our fellow firefighters.

Special media accommodations will be provided at Chico Fire Station 1 from 0645-0700 in preparation of the 0705 observance.

Later, the primary September 11<sup>th</sup> Tribute will be held at 10:00 AM at Chico Fire Station 5, located at 1777 Manzanita Ave. Honor Guard will “post” the colors followed by the traditional bell ringing ceremony lead by Captain Hart.

The public and all public safety agencies are invited to attend both events. Masks will be optional for all community members attending the remembrance.

Special Media accommodations will be provided at both the 7:00am and 10:00am September 11<sup>th</sup> events.
