CITY OF CHICO ANNOUNCES THE CHICO SPRING CLEAN DAY 2022

(Chico, CA – March 15, 2022 –) The City of Chico is proud to announce the Chico Spring Clean Day will be held on **Saturday, April 30th** from **9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.** This annual community cleanup event is in its second year and was inspired by the Chico City Council.

Volunteers may sign up for designated community sections, such as areas of Bidwell Park or downtown Chico, or they may clean up in their own neighborhood. Individuals, schools, businesses, and organizations are invited to help make Chico shine by picking up litter from parks, streets, bike paths, school campuses, waterways, and even empty fields.

“What has now become an annual tradition, Chico’s Spring Clean community clean-up day has an even more special meaning, as it is occurring during Chico’s 150th birthday year!” said Mark Orme, City Manager. “City staff is so proud of the volunteerism that this community exhibits and truly desires to thank those who are willing to give of their time and energy to help make Chico even more beautiful.”

Clean up supplies such as trash bags and litter grabbers will be available for pick up at the Chico Spring Clean Day Headquarters at Hooker Oak Park starting at 8:30 a.m. the day of the event. Debris boxes will be available to drop off refuse at Hooker Oak, Lindo Channel at Manzanita Court, Chapman School, and the Fred Davis Municipal Center (City Hall) parking lot.
