## **CITY OF CHICO RESPONDS TO STORM-RELATED ISSUES**

**(Chico, CA – October 24, 2021 –)** The City of Chico is actively responding to all storm-related issues throughout our community. We wish to reassure our residents that multiple departments including Public Works, the Chico Fire Department, and the Chico Police Department are currently addressing calls for service.

To report flooding, downed tree limbs in the right-of-way, or other immediate infrastructure issues, please call the Chico Police Department non-emergency line at (530) 897-4900. Sand and sandbags are available at our Public Works Department parking lots located at 901 and 965 Fir Street. Residents are advised to bring their own shovel to load sandbags.

Motorists are advised to avoid driving on roadways. Do not drive through barricades. When approaching a traffic signal that has lost power or is in flash, the intersection should be treated as a four-way stop.
