CHICO CITY COUNCILMEMBERS TO BE SWORN IN AND MAYOR AND VICE MAYOR SELECTED ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 6TH

CHICO, CA — (December 1, 2022) - The Chico City Clerk will officially swear in the elected Chico City Councilmembers, and a Mayor and Vice Mayor will be selected on Tuesday, December 6th at 6 p.m. at Chico City Council Chambers, located at 421 Main Street.

Elected Councilmembers who will be sworn in include:

- Kasey Reynolds, District 2 (incumbent)
- Dale Bennett, District 3 (incumbent)
- Addison Winslow, District 4 (newly elected)
- Tom van Overbeek, District 6 (newly elected)

In addition to the swearing-in, the City Council will vote to appoint a Mayor and Vice Mayor from its members, each of which will serve a 2-year term.

Members leaving the Council include Councilmember Alex Brown and Councilmember Mike O'Brien.

Incumbents that are still serving out their term and will remain on the council include:

- Andrew Coolidge, District 5
- Deepika Tandon, District 7
