## **CITY OF CHICO COMPLETES ENCAMPMENT CLEAN-UP AT WINDCHIME PARK**

**CHICO, CA — (Wednesday, November 2, 2022)** - On Thursday, October 27<sup>th</sup>, the City of Chico completed enforcement and cleanup of Windchime Park.

The City's Public Works Operations and Maintenance crews removed a total of 285 cubic yards of trash, weighing 41 tons from Windchime Park during the clean-up efforts.

"We continue to improve health and safety throughout our community. The clean-up efforts in Windchime Park will provide a great benefit to surrounding residents, and those that recreate in the area," said Mark Sorensen, Chico City Manager.
